James Edgar Knight is an Australian born Jugendlicher Heldentenor who represents the very best of the new generation of international opera singers. He possesses a large, bladed voice of great beauty which he employs with considerable technical skill and artistry.

In 2024, Mr. Knight will participate in the finals of the Lauritz Melchior International Singing Competition in Aalborg, Denmark; and make his debut at the Danish National Opera as Manolios (The Greek Passion).

From 2021 to 2024, Mr. Knight was Ensemblemitglied at **Theater Osnabrück** where he sang: Peter Grimes (**Peter Grimes**), Don Carlo (**Don Carlo**), Alfredo Germont (**La Traviata**), Arturo (**Lucia di Lammermoor**), Max Piccolomini (**Wallenstein**), Esteban (**Fremde Erde**), Graf Tassilo (**Gräfin Mariza**), Gabriel von Eistenstein (**Die Fledermaus**), and Manolios (**The Greek Passion**). In 2022, Mr. Knight was named "Sänger des Jahres" and awarded the inaugural Theaterpreis furnished by the Theaterverein Osnabrück in a resounding vote by the Osnabrück audience.

From 2019 to 2021, Mr. Knight was Ensemblemitglied at **Die Theater Chemnitz** where his assignments included: Don José (**Carmen**), Duca di Mantova (**Rigoletto**), Tamino (**Die Zauberflöte**), Pedrillo (**Die Entführung aus dem Serail**), Jaquino (**Fidelio**), Wagner/Nereo (**Mefistofele**), and Froh (**Das Rheingold**).

During the four preceding seasons, from 2015 to 2019, Mr. Knight secured his first professional engagement as the youngest Ensemblemitglied at the Badisches Staatstheater Karlsruhe where he debuted: Mario Cavaradossi (Tosca), Maurizio (Adriana Lecouvreur), Gabriele Adorno (Simon Boccanegra), Alfredo Germont (La Traviata), Macduff (Macbeth), Fenton (Falstaff), Lucio Silla (Lucio Silla), Tybalt (Roméo et Juliette), Jonas (Le Prophète), Froh (Das Rheingold), Junger Diener (Elektra), Erster Gralsritter (Parsifal), and Freddy Eynsford-Hill (My Fair Lady).

James Edgar Knight was born in Sydney and was raised across three continents - growing up in Australia, Hong Kong, and California. Trained and educated in New York City, Mr. Knight holds a Bachelors Degree from the **Mannes School of Music** and a Masters Degree from the prestigious **Juilliard School**. In May 2015, just two days after his graduation from Juilliard and aged only 25, he made his professional debut at **Carnegie Hall** as the Tenor Soloist in **Beethoven's 9th Symphony**.

Mr. Knight has undertaken studies with a wide range of prominent singers and teachers including: Neil Shicoff, Rockwell Blake, John Treleaven, Arthur Levy, and Dan Marek; and has won awards from **The Metropolitan Opera National Council Competition** and **The Opera Index Vocal Competition**. In 2019, Mr. Knight was a finalist at **The Queen Sonja International Music Competition** in Oslo and, in 2020, the **57th Tenor Viñas Singing Contest** in Barcelona.
